PROPOSED ANNEXATION ANXC-734,
APPLICATION OF CITY OF SALEM ZONING
AND WITHDRAWAL FROM SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICTS**

The Salem City Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, November 25, 2019, at 6:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, Civic Center, Salem, Oregon, to consider: 1) Petitioner-initiated, voter-exempt annexation of a 1.06-acre territory located at 1096 Hoffman Road NE, into the City of Salem; 2) Application of City of Salem RA (Residential Agriculture) zoning from Marion County UD (Urban Development) and UT-5 (Urban Transition - 5 Acres) zoning; and 3) Withdrawal from Marion County Fire District #1. Testimony on the Annexation shall be directed toward whether the proposed changes are in conformance with the review criteria set forth under SRC 260.060(c). Testimony on the application of City of Salem zoning shall be directed to the criteria as set forth in SRC 260.060(c). Testimony on the Withdrawal, which is not a land use decision, shall be directed toward whether such withdrawal is for the best interest of the City. Testimony may also address any other criteria a person believes applies to the proposed changes. Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the decision maker and the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes an appeal of action on the annexation to the Land Use Board of Appeals on that issue. A similar failure to raise constitutional issues relating to proposed conditions of approval precludes an action for damages in circuit court. Any participant may request an opportunity to present additional evidence, arguments or testimony regarding the application. The City Council shall grant such request by continuing the public hearing or leaving the record open for additional written evidence, arguments or testimony. Prior to the hearing, a copy of the application, all documents and evidence submitted by or on behalf of the applicant and applicable criteria are available for inspection at no cost and copies will be provided at reasonable cost.

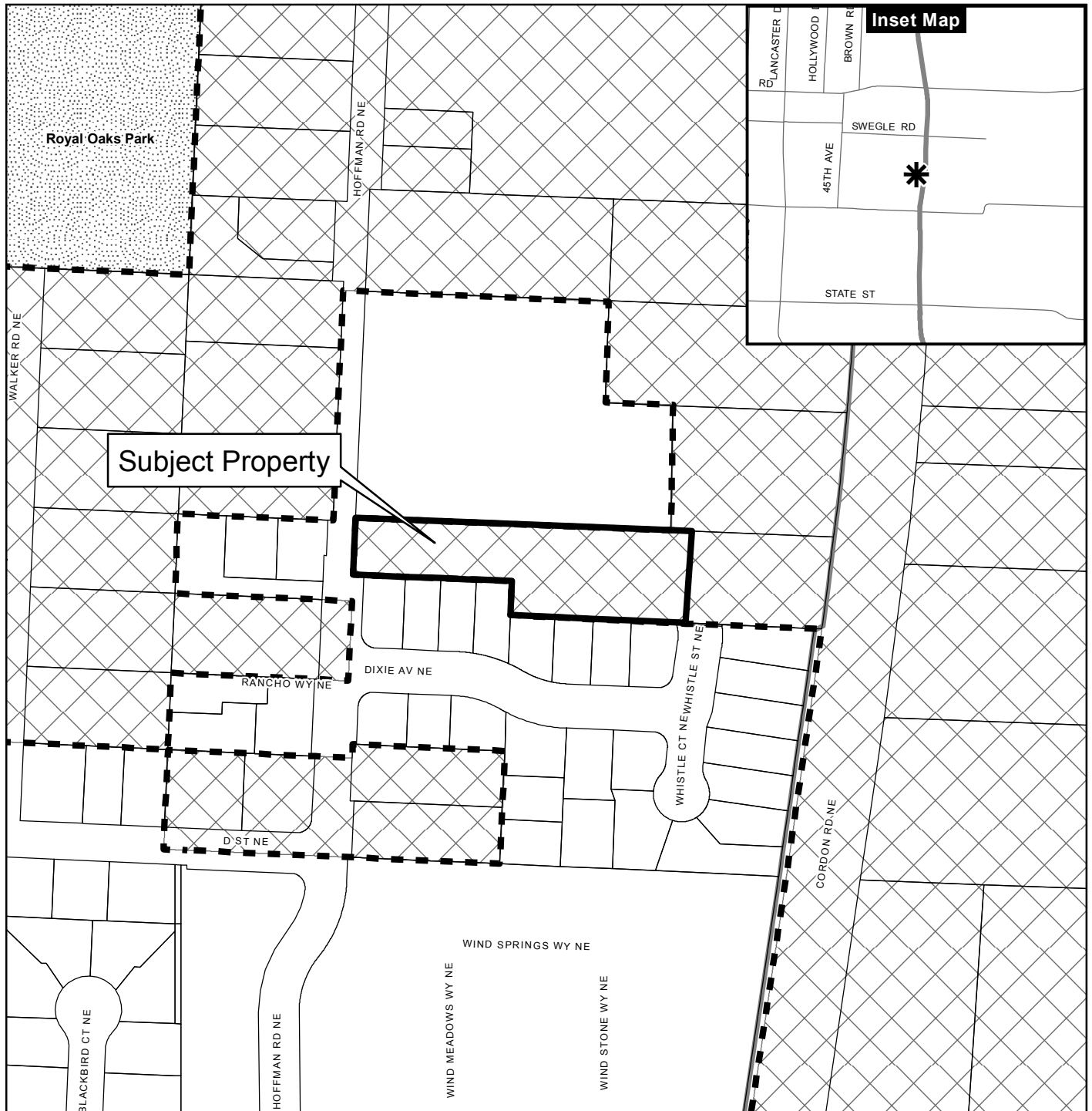



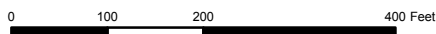

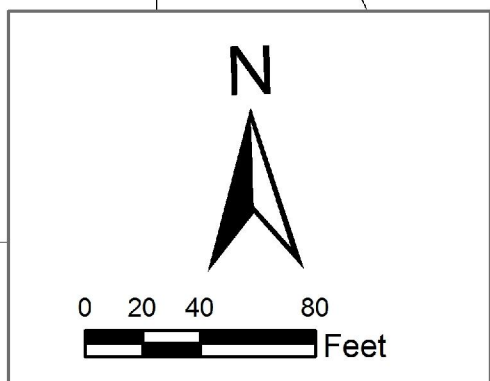
