Dear Salem Property Owner/Resident:

The City of Salem is planning to construct roadway safety improvements on Union Street NE (see attached map). The project will provide bike facilities along both sides of Union Street NE to connect the Union Street pedestrian/bicycle bridge to the north Capitol Mall area via Summer Street NE. In addition, the improvements include installation of a new traffic signal at the Liberty Street NE intersection.

During the initial stages of design, survey crews will be gathering boundary and topographic information and may need to enter your property. Temporary and/or permanent survey monuments may be required. All monuments will be clearly marked, and any temporary monuments will be removed following project completion.

The survey work will be conducted by Harper Houf Peterson Righellis (HHPR). On the first day of the work, HHPR would normally attempt to make contact with you on-site. However, due to current public health concerns crews will not make personal contact with anyone at the property when they arrive. A notice to make you aware of their visit per Oregon Revised Statute 672.047 will be left on site in a conspicuous location. If you have questions regarding the survey work, please contact the survey manager, John Campbell, PLS, during normal business hours at 503-799-8612.

This project is being funded by a combination of a federal "All Roads and Transportation Safety" grant and City of Salem Urban Renewal Agency matching funds. Construction is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2022.


