a. <u>Historic Design Review –Case No. HIS21-02 for 1500 Summer St SE</u> Major Historic Design Review of a proposal to construct a new two story house within the Gaiety Hill/Bush's Pasture Park National Register Historic District on property zoned RS (Single Family Residential) and located at 1500 Summer Street SE, (Marion County Assessors Map and Tax Lot number: 073W34AB00600).

<u>Staff Recommendation:</u> Based upon the information presented in the application, plans submitted for review, and findings as presented in this staff report, staff recommends that the Historic Landmarks Commission APPROVE the proposal with the following CONDITIONS of APPROVAL:

Condition 1: In order to reduce the potential adverse effect of the construction on the existing

oak trees proposed for retention on the eastern portion property, the applicant shall utilize a pier style foundation under the eastern porch instead of a traditional foundation wall or slab so the building pressure exerted on the tree

root system is limited to these pier locations.

Condition 2: The proposed retaining walls shall be terraced, so that no section of the

retaining wall exceeds 4' in height.
