The City Council meeting and the hearing will be conducted virtually. No in-person attendance is possible; however, public comment is still allowed (see "How to Provide Testimony"). PROPERTY LOCATION:

4650 & 4680 Hazelgreen Road NE and Adjacent Lands

DESCRIPTION of REQUEST:

Annexation of territory approximately 16.06 acres in size, including 0.44 acres within the right-of-way of Hazelgreen Road NE and 15.62 acres of private property located at 4650 & 4680 Hazelgreen Road NE (Marion County Assessor Map 062W32C / 000500 and 000400), currently designated "Industrial" in the Salem Area Comprehensive Plan (SACP) and zoned Marion County UT-20-IND (Urban Transition 20 Acres - Industrial), with a concurrent Comprehensive Plan Change to "Multi-Family Residential" and Zone Change to City of Salem RM-II (Multiple Family Residential II) for approximately 13.7 acres or private property, a Comprehensive Plan Change to "Mixed Use" and Zone Change to City of Salem MU-II (Mixed Use-II) MU-I (Mixed Use I) for approximately 1.8 acres of private property, and withdrawal from the Marion County Fire District #1.

To provide written testimony: Persons wishing to submit written testimony must do so no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the hearing by emailing cityrecorder@cityofsalem.net or by depositing written comments in the drop box located at the City Recorder's Office, 555 Liberty Street SE, Room 225, Salem, Oregon 97301.

HEARING PROCEDURE:

The hearing will be conducted with the staff presentation first, followed by the applicant's case, neighborhood association comments, persons in favor or opposition, and rebuttal by the applicant, if necessary. The applicant has the burden of proof to show that the approval criteria can be satisfied by the facts. Opponents may rebut the applicant's testimony by showing alternative facts or by showing that the evidence submitted does not satisfy the approval criteria.

Failure to raise an issue prior to the close of the Public Hearing in person or in writing, or failure to provide statements or evidence with sufficient specificity to provide the applicant and Review Authority to respond to the issue, precludes appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) on this issue. A similar failure to raise constitutional issues relating to proposed conditions of approval precludes an action for damages in circuit court.

Following the close of the Public Hearing, a decision will be issued and mailed to the applicant, property owner, affected neighborhood associations, anyone who participated in the hearing, either in person or in writing, and anyone who requested to receive notice of the decision.




