SCAN Goals For 2023 – 2024

About SCAN Board Members:

SCAN's board may have up to 20 members. Board members are elected by neighbors at the annual meeting but may also be appointed by the Board between annual meetings.

To be qualified to serve on the board, a person must live in SCAN, own property located in SCAN, or represent a business, school, non-profit or faith-based organization located in SCAN.

Neighbors may nominate themselves or others (with their agreement) for a board position at the annual meeting.
