Goals for the 2024 year. Ideas included:

- Continue to monitor North campus, Center Street property.
- Parks improvements and possible Salem Parks Foundation grant
  - Use the giant walnut tree that is being held back for NESCA to add two benches and two signs or four benches to the D Street Park.
  - More trees in the neighborhood
  - Host an event in one of our parks (requires planning to be in early January).
    - Make Music Salem
- Work with Hoover School, possibly check with the parents' group.
- Safer streets and crosswalks, pedestrian friendly sidewalks
  - Look for opportunities with Land-Use cases when driveways, etc. are planned, to see if we could ask for a crosswalk, a light, etc. Developers are very often very receptive to working with neighborhoods when letters are sent in favor of the project to the Planning Commission.
  - The neighborhood plan, approved by the City Council, also provides some leverage to help.
- Outreach to add NESCA membership.
  - Possible door-to-door to our neighbors in the new private homes.
  - National Night Out
  - Talk to Summer and Madison (The Jory) about their community having their own NNO event there or at the D Street Park
- Charitable Drives (two or three)
  - Socks for HOMES
  - Coats
  - School Supplies
- Litter Patrol
- Host a candidate forum (possibly in conjunction with another NA)
- Information via newsletters/minutes to the community
- Fulfill NA requirements for the city.
  - Monthly Minutes (News optional)
  - Distribute City of Salem information
  - Keep Chair and Board positions filled; actively engage in board and committee planning.
