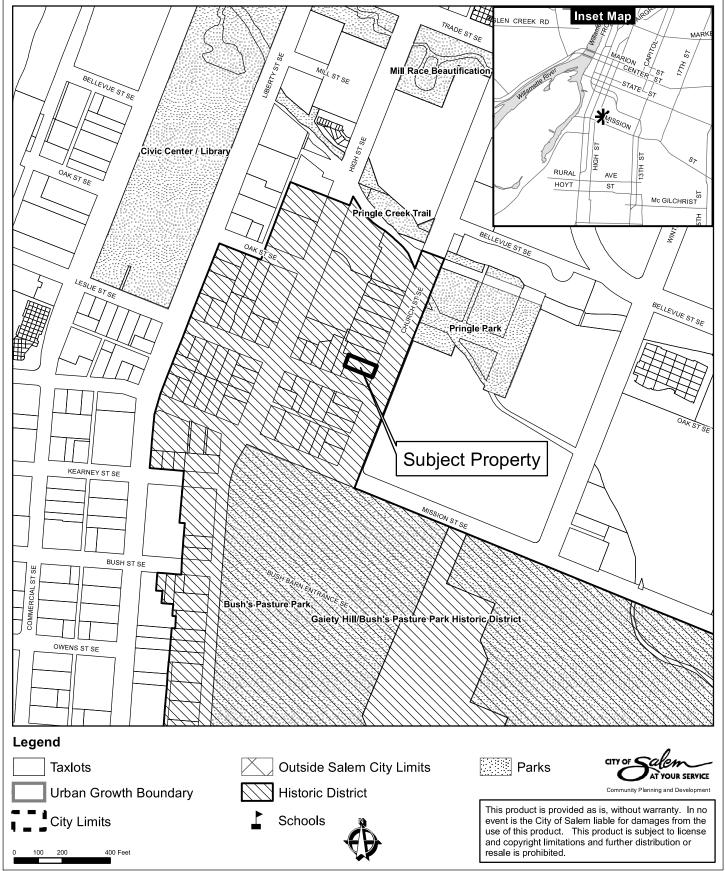

Sec. 230.025. - Standards for historic contributing buildings in residential historic districts.

(h)Decks. Replacement and addition of decks in historic contributing buildings is allowed.

(1)Materials. The deck shall be constructed of wood, a wood composite, or a material available during the period of significance.

Response: The replacement stairs on the back of the building at 685 Church St SE will be constructed of wood, either clear cedar, fir, or hemlock.

(2)Design. The deck shall:

(A)Be located off the rear of the resource.

Response: The replacement stairs will be located off the rear of the main residence at 685 Church St SE, and will not be visible from any street view.

(B)Not obscure any significant architectural features of the resource.

Response: The replacement stairs will not hide any significant architectural feature of the home at 685 Church St SE.

(C)Be of a reasonable size and scale in relationship to the resource.

Response: The replacement stairs will be proportional and reasonable in size to the existing resource structure.

(D)Shall not extend beyond the width of the existing footprint of the resource.

Response: The stairs will not extend beyond the width of the existing footpring of the house at 685 Church St SE.
