a. Historic Design Review - Case No. HIS24-03 for 460 Bush St SE

Class 3 Major Historic Design Review of a proposal to rehabilitate the exterior including removing non-historic vinyl siding, fenestration, and lighting, and replacing primarily with historically accurate wooden windows and cedar siding, and historically accurate lighting, and constructing a granite stone retaining wall at 460 Bush Street SE (c. 1920), a historic contributing property in the Gaiety Hill/Bush's Pasture Park Historic District in the CO (Commercial Office) and RS (Single Family Residential) zones. (Marion County Assessor Map and Tax Lot Numbers: 073W27CA04300 and 073W27CA02800)

<u>Staff Recommendation:</u> Based upon the information presented in the application, plans submitted for review, and findings as presented in this staff report, staff recommends that the Historic Landmarks Commission **APPROVE** the proposal with the following Conditions of Approval:

Condition 1: The applicant shall modify the retaining wall design so that columns are no more than 30" in height.

Condition 2: The applicant shall obtain a Public Works revokable encroachment permit per SRC 76.160 prior to the issuance of any city permits authorizing work on the property.

Condition 3: The applicant shall submit final design specification of the exterior lighting on the primary façade and retaining wall to the Historic Preservation Officer at the time of building permit submittal.
