ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION - MINOR HISTORIC REVIEW

DECISION DATE: February 2, 2016

REQUEST: Minor administrative historic design review to modify the administrative

decision (HIS14-21MOD) approving installation of 6 "Art Wells" at sidewalk corner locations, to 7 "Art Wells" at sidewalk corner locations within the Downtown Salem Historic District, on properties zoned CB (Central Business District). The applicant does not propose any changes to the design of the Art Wells, each of which would consist of a 6 by 6 square foot opening in the sidewalk covered by a cast iron grate, similar to the approved tree well

design.

CRITERIA: Salem Revised Code (SRC) Chapter 230

FINDINGS: The applicant requests to <u>modify</u> the November 4, 2014 decision by the Urban Planning Administrator (HIS14-21MOD / AMANDA No. 14-117245-DR) to approve installation of "Art Wells" at 6 sidewalk corner locations within the Downtown Salem Historic District. In the modified proposal, the applicant proposes a total of 7 sidewalk corner locations within the Historic District.

In HIS14-21, and HIS 14-21MOD, staff reviewed the proposal for art wells for compliance with the standards for streetscape improvements in commercial historic districts as provided in SRC 230.075(a) and (b). Staff found that the decorative pattern of the cast iron grating is compatible with the character of the streetscape within the historic district, and that no significant historic sidewalk features that contribute to the Downtown Historic District would be disturbed by the installation of the proposed art wells. The applicant has not proposed any changes to the design of the art wells or the method of installation. Additionally, Public Works staff have found that the proposed new art well location meets applicable Public Works standards. Staff has reviewed the request for modification and finds that the new proposed locations for art wells would not affect compliance with the standards of SRC 230.075.

DECISION: Based upon the application materials deemed complete on January 29, 2016, and the findings as presented in this report, the application is APPROVED.






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Vicinity Map SALEM DOWNTOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT





Downtown Art Well Locations Salem Public Art Commission






D wntown Streetscape

REQUEST: Minor administrative historic design review to modify the administrative

decision (HIS14-21) approving installation of 9 "Art Wells" at sidewalk corner locations, to 6 "Art Wells" at sidewalk corner locations within the Downtown Salem Historic District, on properties zoned CB (Central Business District). The applicant does not propose any changes to the design of the Art Wells, each of which would consist of a 6 by 6 square foot opening in the sidewalk covered by a cast iron grate, similar to the approved tree well design.

FINDINGS: The applicant requests to <u>modify</u> the June 26, 2014 decision by the Urban Planning Administrator (HIS14-21 / AMANDA No. 14-110995-DR) to approve installation of "Art Wells" at 9 sidewalk corner locations within the Downtown Salem Historic District. In the modified proposal, the applicant proposes a total of 6 sidewalk corner locations within the Historic District, including 4 that remain unchanged from the original proposal.

In HIS14-21, staff reviewed the proposal for art wells for compliance with the standards for streetscape improvements in commercial historic districts as provided in SRC 230.075(a) and (b). Staff found that the decorative pattern of the cast iron grating is compatible with the character of the streetscape within the historic district, and that no significant historic sidewalk features that contribute to the Downtown Historic District would be disturbed by the installation of the proposed art wells. The applicant has not proposed any changes to the design of the art wells or the method of installation. Staff has reviewed the request for modification and finds that the new proposed locations for art wells would not affect compliance with the standards of SRC 230.075.

DECISION: Based upon the application materials deemed complete on October 15, 2014, and the findings as presented in this report, the application is APPROVED.


