1. ROLL CALL AND INTRODUCTIONS

3. NEIGHBORHOOD PETITION REGARDING 10-HOUR PAY STATIONS ON CHURCH STREET SE

Gaiety Hill residents received a City-initiated letter dated March 27, 2018, informing them that the City is proposing to install 10-hour parking meter pay stations on the 600 block of Church Street SE. The neighbors submitted a petition to the City asking that the limit be modified to 3-hours. Neighbors from the immediate project area came to tonight’s meeting and reiterated the request in the petition, and added a request that the three hour limit be without charge. The neighbors’ consideration is for the children and parents that park on the east side of Church Street SE to use Salem Hospital’s new playground facility, and that the proposed project area is a residential neighborhood not in the Central Business District (CBD).

Staff explained that the parking station installations were previously approved by City Council. Because staff could not provide public notice prior to the CATC meeting, CATC was asked to determine if a public hearing, regarding the time limit, should be held before or after installation of the parking meters.

Motion: Commissioner Ledger moved a recommendation to City Council that the parking meters proposed for installation on Church Street SE not be installed until a public hearing is held. Motion seconded.

Vote: All in favor.

4. PROCESS FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL REQUESTS

The second item on the agenda, Process for Traffic Control Requests, was not discussed and will be placed on a future CATC agenda.
