Police Report

Officer Owings stated the transient camp under I-5 at Mission is now cleaned up as is the Turner Road and I-5 underpass. The parks have now been posted with closed from sunset to sunrise but the signs don't include disabled and no smoking notification - that is in the works now. A parks employee was attacked when a person was asked to move from a no parking space. The number of motor homes has dwindled. The fence under I-5 to Home Depot was cut soon after installation. He cautioned us to be very careful on Turner Road after a serious accident at Airport Road.

Parks Foundation

Dan Saucy of Salem Parks Foundation explained the parks foundation purpose and how to get a grant. For example, the dog park needs a drinking fountain for dogs and people and it needs a handicap entrance.

Parole and Probation

Sally Ramsey of Parole and Probation gave us an update on that department.

Committee Reports

Land use - Rumor has it that Costco will be moving to an area on 27th Street some time in the future.

Transit – Extended services have been moved from January to September, 2019. There are four meetings regarding extended service with the nearest one being at the South Salem Senior Center February 21 from 4 to 6. Public input ends March 16. Airport – for operations in January – business 539, overflights 107. fun flights 2035, for a total of 2681. Busiest day was 161. Question about helicopter noise, if it is a Chinook those pilots don't need authorization because they are practicing night flights. Corban University – they now offer an agriculture business degree. There is a \$6 million capital improvement project going on for their athletic facilities. Basketball is ending and soon baseball. softball and track will be starting.
